Care Resource provides comprehensive primary medical and preventive care, including dental care, in-house pharmacy services and behavioral health/substance abuse services, to all individuals in South Florida's diverse communities.

Services

Primary Medical Care

Care Resource offers comprehensive primary medical care at an affordable cost. These services are available at all of the Care Resource offices in Miami-Dade and Broward counties, hours may vary by location.

Care Resource's Primary Medical Services include:

- Routine adult health maintenance visits
- Physical examinations
- Blood pressure screenings
- Cancer screenings
- Nutrition consultations
- Chronic disease management & education
- Well-woman and gynecological care
- Referrals to specialists

Sliding-Fee Scale



Clients who are uninsured may be eligible for our Sliding-Fee Scale Program where they can receive medical care at an affordable cost. Eligibility for the program is based on gross household income and family size.

Services



Pediatric Care

Care Resource pediatric medical care is available for children from infancy to 18 years of age. Pediatric Services are available at Care Resource's Midtown Miami and Little Havana offices, hours may vary by location.

Pediatric Services include:

- Routine health screenings and adolescent care
- Well-child care
- Pediatric hearing, vision and dental care
- Immunizations
- Sports physicals

Care Resource behavioral health professionals will provide counseling services to adolescents, based on a referral from primary care providers



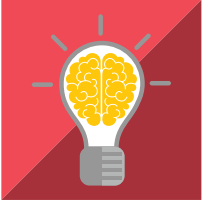
Dental Care

Care Resource offers complete dental care to make sure your smile stays healthy. Dental Services are available at Care Resource's Midtown Miami and Ft. Lauderdale offices, hours may vary by location.

Dental Services include:

- Routine check-ups and cleanings
- Children's dental screenings and treatment
- Composite and/or amalgam fillings and extractions
- Crowns, fixed bridges, and bleaching
- Full and partial dentures

Behavioral Health

Care Resource's diverse behavioral health and substance abuse services and programs will help you manage your emotional and psychological well-being, so you can thrive.

Behavioral Health services include:

Counseling and therapy

- Individual counseling
- Group counseling
- Psycho-educational groups
- Health and behavioral services

Outpatient substance abuse services include

- Evaluations
- Individual and group counseling
- Outpatient program services
- Referrals to more intensive treatment programs as needed



Case Management

Care Resource's Case Managers are available to assist in coordinating your care by assessing your eligibility for programs and services to help support your health.

Together, you and a Case Manager will identify your needs and develop a plan of care.

Case Management services include assistance with:

- Insurance and pharmacy coverage
- Income entitlement programs
- Job training and education programs
- Housing and transportation
- Emergency and financial assistance
- Substance abuse programs
- Behavioral health support
- Concrete needs such as: food, clothing, eyeglasses, and medically necessary items

Case managers also help with referrals, advocacy, and developing and maintaining realistic health care plans.

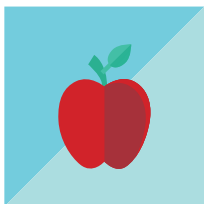
LGBT Health Care

Care Resource is dedicated to providing affirming, expert care to LGBT individuals. Our health care providers and staff are knowledgeable in all aspects of lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender care. Care Resource has been designated an "Equality Leader" by the Healthcare Equality Index (HEI).

Care Resource's LGBT Health Care services include:

- Primary medical care
- Dental services
- Women's wellness
- Behavioral health including substance abuse services
- HIV/AIDS and Hepatitis C specialty care
- STD screenings and free HIV testing
- Pharmacy services
- Nutrition services
- Case management services
- Transgender health care

Care Resource's providers are trained to offer health care specific to the needs of transgender individuals. Our providers adhere generally to the World Professional Association for Transgender Health (WPATH) Standards of Care (formerly known as the Harry Benjamin Standards of Care).



Nutrition Services

Care Resource's Registered Dietitian will help you maintain your health with support and guidance for better eating; because eating right, not only makes you feel better, it makes you look better too. Our Nutritional Services include assessments and education.

People who may benefit from our Nutrition Services include those with:

- Weight concerns - either overweight or underweight
- HIV or Hepatitis C
- Diabetes
- Hypertension (high blood pressure)

Specialized HIV Care & Support Services

If you've been diagnosed with HIV/AIDS, Hepatitis C, or another infectious disease, you can live a long and enjoyable life.

Our infectious disease health care services provide you with more than just treatment for the disease - we partner with you to help you stay healthy and happy.

Care Resource's HIV/AIDS and Infectious Disease Medical Care services include:

- Primary medical care
- Dental services
- Nutrition consultations & guidance to help you maintain a healthy weight
- Behavioral health services including psychiatrists and support groups
- Substance abuse services
- Effective medications to fight HIV
- Pharmacy services
- On-going case management
- Linkage and retention programs



The Food for Life Network provides food bank services and home delivered meals to those living with HIV and their dependents. This service is offered in Miami-Dade County, and eligibility is based on income, and health and dietary needs.

Pharmacy Services

Care Resource offers on-site pharmacy services at our Midtown Miami and Ft. Lauderdale locations thanks to our partnership with Walgreens.

Walgreens offers exceptional level of individualized service, to include:

- Free “same day” home delivery service (right to your door in a safe, secure and confidential package.)
- One-on-one patient counseling
- Customized inventory, plus hard-to-find medications
- Regular patient and physician communication to assist with adherence
- Specialty HIV/AIDS trained pharmacists

Additionally, Curanthealth is our mail order partner pharmacy, which provides medication management programs and services directly to your front door.

- Specialty HIV/AIDS pharmacists and technicians

Health Screenings

Care Resource offers walk-in testing services to anyone.

Our HIV/STD screening services include:

HIV Counseling, Testing, and Referral

- Free and confidential
- Walk-in service only
- Oral swab or finger stick (OraQuick) and confirmation of reactive results by blood
- Rapid test results in 20 minutes

STD Screening and Treatment

- Current Care Resource patients: please make an appointment with your provider or walk-in.
- Non-patients: Free screening for chlamydia, gonorrhea, and syphilis
- Treatment services offered based on diagnosis.*

Other health screening services include:

Glucose, Cholesterol & Blood Pressure Screening

- Current Care Resource patients: please make an appointment with your provider or walk-in.
- Non-patients without health insurance: screenings for glucose, cholesterol & blood pressure are available at no cost
- Treatment referrals as needed based on screening results.*

Hepatitis C Rapid Testing

- Current Care Resource patients: please make an appointment with your provider or walk-in.
- Non-patients without health insurance: Free rapid screening by finger-stick and confirmation of reactive results by blood
- Rapid test results in 20 minutes
- Referrals available for treatment based on confirmatory results

*Uninsured clients may be eligible for our discount program

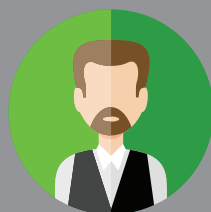
